Section Rules: Amateur Photography only - No Professional Photography

PHOTOGRAPHY Exhibits (including juniors) must be handed to the Secretary or appropriate Steward before 3pm on Wednesday, 18th October 2017. **Entries close on this date.**

Number of Entries: Maximum of (3) three entries per class is permitted.

Conditions:

- All entries must have entrants name, phone number, section (P) & class to be clearly marked on the back in the middle of the photo.
- Previously exhibited work in this competition is not accepted.
- Visible photo minimum size is 20cm x 20cm or 14cm x 25cm panorama/rectangle.
- All photos are to be mounted on 'STIFF' BLACK CARD with 2cm border approx. & securely fixed to mount. Velcro dots or strips fixed to the back on each corner of the card.
- Competition is open to all amateur photographers (unless specified) and must be the work of the Exhibitor. The definition of amateur for this competition is someone who does not get the majority of their income from photography.
- All entries will be judged (unless the judge deems the subject unsuitable)
- Photos can be collected from 4.30pm on Saturday, 20th October.
- All care is taken when photos are handled, however, stewards' accept no responsibility for loss or damage.

Note: Make sure photo is entered into the right category, if not sure check with office administration when entering photography.

2018 WHEAT & SHEEP/WOOL THEME - 21x29cm (A4)

Class

1. Open – Wheat & Sheep/Wool Theme.
Depicting sheep shearing,
drafting sheep, wool skirting, etc.

COLOUR OR MONOCHROME PRINTS – Max. 21X29cm (A4)

2. Landscape – show the natural scenery of the terrain, can use buildings, trees &/or people, but they should not dominate the image.
3. Waterscape – show the natural scenery
4. Sunrise or Sunset
5. Rock Study – a picture of rocks in natural state.
6. Animal, Bird or Insect Study
Where the subject dominates the picture.
7. Character Study
Showing the personality of the subject, can use props.

COLOUR OR MONOCHROME PRINT

Maximum Size 10x15cm (postcard) – Maximum 3 entries per entrant per class

8. Animal Kingdom – Animal, bird, insect or fish. Domestic or wild
9. Floral Study – Single or multiple blooms, whole flower or part thereof.
10. Sunrise/Sunset
11. Waterscape
12. Humorous study
13. Monochrome - Open
14. 'Living Healthy' - depicting healthy lifestyle

PANORAMA – Maximum 50cm

Panorama (min. ratio 2:1, prints not allowed to be longer than 50cm)

15. Waterscape
16. Landscape – showing the natural scenery
17. Sports in action

9 – 12 YEARS

Award presented for: Overall Points Winner

1. Human Subject - e.g. friends, parents, siblings
2. My Pet
3. Holiday or School Camp activity
4. Animal Study: A picture of one or more (or part of one) animals where the subject dominates the picture

13 – 16 YEARS

Award presented for: Overall Points Winner

1. Farm Scene or Activity
2. Animal, Bird or Insect Study: close up where the subject dominates the picture
3. Your Pet
4. Flower Close-up
5. Landscape – A picture of natural scenery, which may include trees, people, houses or other objects, provided that these elements do not dominate the picture.
6. Human Subject e.g. Child, Parents, Friend, etc.
