Judging criteria for a junior craftwork competition at the Narrogin Agricultural Show, the judging criteria should encourage creativity, effort, skill development, and age-appropriate expression.:

- 1. **Creativity and Originality:** Judges will assess the level of creativity and originality demonstrated in the craftwork.
- Effort and Skill Development: The effort and skill development shown in creating
 the craftwork will be evaluated. Judges may consider factors such as the complexity
 of the craft, the use of different techniques or materials, and the level of
 craftsmanship relative to the participant's age.
- 3. **Adherence to Instructions:** If there are specific instructions or guidelines for the competition, judges will consider how well the participant follows these instructions while still demonstrating creativity and individuality.
- 4. **Use of Materials:** Judges may assess how effectively and creatively the materials have been used. This includes the choice of materials, their quality, and how well they contribute to the overall design of the craftwork.
- 5. **Technique and Execution:** The technical skill and execution of the craftwork will be evaluated. Judges may consider factors such as neatness, attention to detail, precision in cuts or stitches, and overall craftsmanship.
- 6. **Age-Appropriate Expression:** Craftwork that reflects the participant's age and developmental stage while showcasing creativity and effort will receive recognition. Judges will appreciate entries that demonstrate age-appropriate skills and expression.
- 7. **Presentation:** The presentation of the craftwork is important. Judges will consider factors such as cleanliness, arrangement, labelling (if applicable), and overall attractiveness of the display.
- 8. **Theme Relevance (if applicable):** If there's a specific theme for the competition, judges will consider how well the craftwork aligns with the theme.
- 9. **Practicality and Functionality (if applicable):** For craft items that serve a functional purpose, judges may evaluate how well the item fulfills its intended function while maintaining aesthetic appeal and quality craftsmanship.
- 10. **Overall Impression:** Judges will consider the overall impression of the craftwork, taking into account all the above criteria to determine how well-rounded, creative, and age-appropriate the entry is compared to others.

These criteria aim to foster a positive and encouraging environment for junior participants, allowing them to explore their creativity, develop new skills, and showcase their craftwork in a supportive setting.
